Restrictions on outdoor tobacco use, categorized by policy type



## 100% Tobacco-Free Campuses (No tobacco use anywhere on college premises)

- Clark College (in Vancouver, WA; tobacco-free since Spring 2006)
- Mt. Hood Community College (since January 2010)
- Oregon Coast Community College (since Spring 2009)
- Portland Community College (since Fall 2009)
- Tillamook Bay Community College (since January 2010)

## Designated Outdoor Smoking Areas

- Central Oregon Community College (parking lots)
- Clackamas Community College
- Clatsop Community College
- Columbia Gorge Community College (parking lots)
- Klamath Community College
- Lane Community College (core of campus tobacco-free)
- Linn-Benton Community College
- Rogue Community College
- Umpqua Community College (core of campus tobacco-free)

## Smoking Prohibited within Specified Distance from Building Entrances

- Blue Mountain Community College (25 feet)
- Chemeketa Community College (20 feet) <sup>1</sup>

## No Smoking within 10 feet of Entrances, Windows & Air Intakes (minimum distance required by Oregon Smokefree Workplace Law)

- Southwestern Oregon Community College
- Treasure Valley Community College <sup>2</sup>
