

## Secondhand Smoke Role-Plays

---

### Situation 1:

A parent brings his/her child to school every day reeking of cigarette smoke.

#### Roles:

- You are a very quiet and shy mom. Your husband is the dominant one in your household and he smokes continually.
- You are a staff member very concerned about the health of the student.

### Situation 2:

Right before Parent Night, two of the parents are smoking right outside the door before coming into the building.

#### Roles:

- You are a mom, very outspoken, feeling guilty and defiant about your smoking because you know you should quit.
- You are a dad who is trying very hard to quit smoking.
- You are a staff member trying to provide good modeling to kids and other parents and also wanting to link those who want to quit up with the Oregon Tobacco Quit Line

### Situation 3:

You know that a mother of one of the kids is pregnant with another baby. You see her smoking one morning as she's getting the kids out of her car.

#### Roles:

- You are the pregnant mom. You are very stressed because you are working, taking care of the kids and now you are having another baby. Cigarettes help to relieve some of the stress.
- You are a staff member who knows that smoking is a terrible health risk for the unborn child. You are very concerned about the health of this unborn baby and you want to protect your student from secondhand smoke.
